

Treblinka Death Camp is the largest cemetery of Polish Jews with around 900,000 people murdered there between July 1942 and September 1943.

For many years their identities remained unknown.

The **The Memory of Treblinka Foundation**, established in 2015, aims to gather and disseminate information about Treblinka by collating existing witness and survivor reports, and conducting historical and archaeological research.

Together with the Jewish Historical Institute in Warsaw, this research has currently 108,926 victims recorded in the Book of Names.
